What is EHLS?

Native speakers of critical languages are in high demand in the U.S. government. EHLS trains advanced English speakers to be effective communicators and strong candidates for federal jobs.

EHLS participants receive a full scholarship for tuition and a living stipend from the National Security Education Program (NSEP). Upon completion of the program, EHLS Scholars have a service obligation of one year to be served in a position related to national security in a federal agency.
